OTHER DETAILS

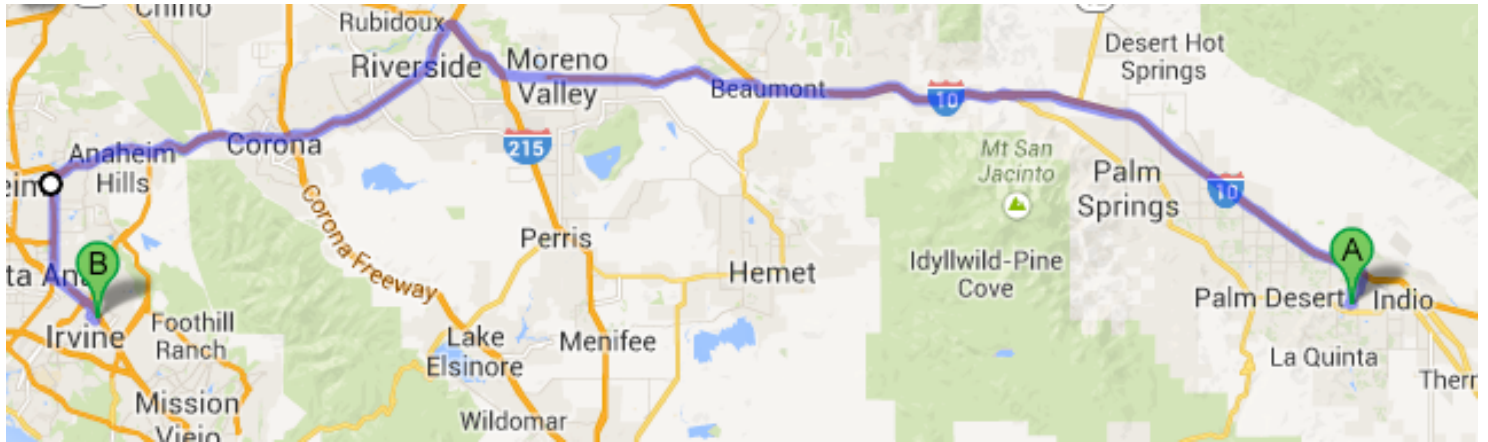

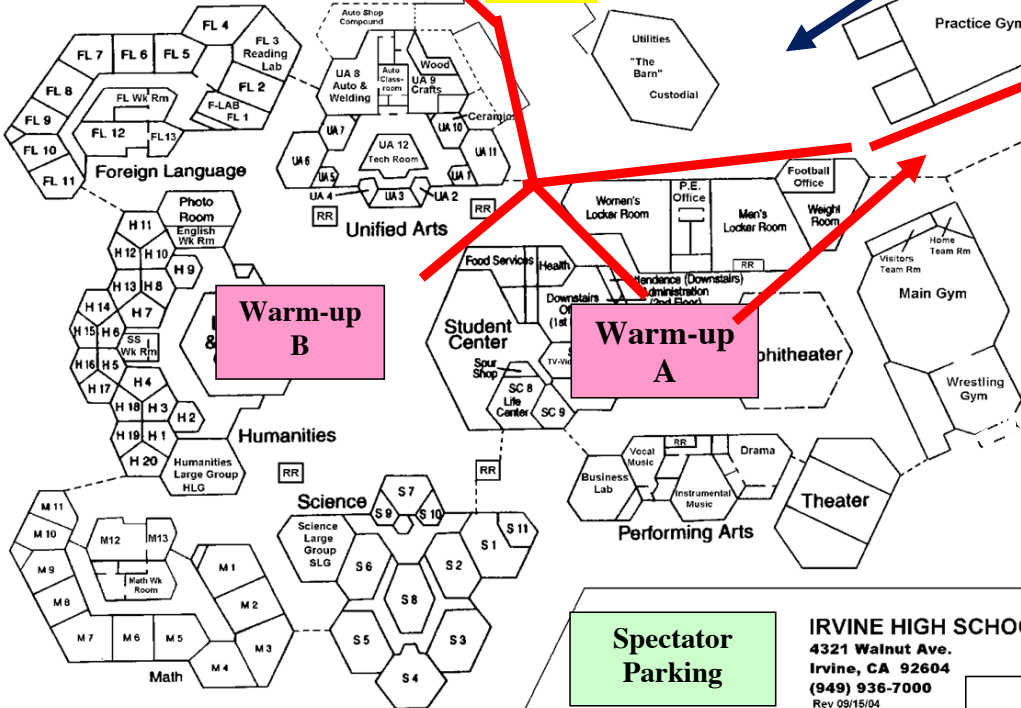

FROM THE SHOW HOST:

PARKING: All buses enter via Escolar and will be directed to the performers' parking area. A guide will meet you to assist in all aspects of your preparations. **Spectator parking** is located off Walnut and Yale at Heritage Park or in front lot. **THIS IS OUR FIRST YEAR WITH SOLAR PANELS, PLEASE BE PATIENT WITH OUR PARENTS AS THEY DO THEIR BEST TO ACCOMMODATE YOUR REQUESTS.**

TICKETS: Each director will receive a name badge for **each** of your staff listed on your entry form. **Students** will have their hand stamped upon arrival. Each school will receive **one** wrist band for every **10** performers, to be used by "chaperone", support personnel i.e. pit/props, etc. Please have chaperones with your group after their performance. Spectators may purchase tickets at the ticket booth at the cost of \$8.00 for adults and \$6.00 for children (5-14), and senior citizens. Children 5 & under are free.

DRESSING: There will be no formal dressing rooms available. Please use your own vehicles to change.

FOOD: We will have a wide variety of food available. **Please note that the city of Irvine does not allow barbecues on the campus.** We ask that you do not put us in the awkward situation of asking you not to use your barbecue.

VIDEO: We will provide you with a DVD of your performance. No parents allowed on top of the press box (judges are there).

WARM-UP: There are two warm-up areas. Area **A** is the amphitheater. Warm-up **B** is a quad area. Drum lines can use either location on the map. If you have a desire to "march" during warm-up, we recommend the practice field directly behind the press box (**obviously, there is no playing here**). The soccer field at Heritage Park will also be available for marching only. Be sure you do not disturb the performing groups (or a 1 point penalty will be assessed).

PIT PERCUSSION: Only ATV or electric carts are allowed on the track- **no street or full size vehicles will be permitted.** We no longer have pit assistance available to help you.

STAGING/HOLDING AREA: Your pit crew should arrive here one group prior to your performance. (This is noted on the map) An adult will be there to tell you when you may enter the field for competition. **It is YOUR responsibility to get your unit there 10 minutes prior to your actual performance time.** This will give you time for last minute adjustment/emergency repairs, group instructions, etc.

ELECTRICAL POWER: We will do our best to provide 110-volt power for your equipment in the pit. We suggest that you have a "back up" source of battery power available just in case the power source should blow a fuse. **The final responsibility of providing electrical power for amplified equipment rests on the shoulders of the competitor.**

EXITING THE FIELD: Upon completion of your show. Exit the front sidelines, turn left and then exit through the gate at the end of the track. Proceed to the parking lot or your assigned seating, following your performance on a SOFT RIM TAP. Failure to observe this may result in a 1-point penalty.

BAND SEATING: All bands will receive an assigned seating chart upon their arrival in the parking lot. **PLEASE SIT IN YOUR ASSIGNED AREA.** It would also be helpful for you to have some of your chaperones with your group at this time.
